

FISHING REPORT – LIMAY RIVER LODGE PATAGONIA ARGENTINA




I'm trying to think of a word to summarize it and that word might be "magnitude". The fishing on the Limay River totally exceeded our most optimistic expectations. We were not aware of the magnitude of the fishing quality and consistency, all what we are experiencing right now, as I write this text

Like I've been telling friends... lately, on the Limay, it's been hard to catch a fish under twenty inches. And these fish are in fabulous condition. They fight like hell! And they love to feed on the surface. Resident rainbows range between 19 and 23+ inches and resident browns can get as big as 28 inches or even more. And they'll attack attractors like there is no tomorrow. There are also great mayfly and caddis hatches that will invite you to match them. Streamers have also worked well, especially on big early migrating browns. The river is packed with food of all sorts, and therefore it's packed with great fish too. My arm is hurting at the end of the day... of playing fish! This is what I mean by magnitude: the magnitude of the experience!

Now we are starting to focus on the migratory browns that are gradually growing in numbers as we are approaching our fall, yet we'll still be fishing dries all we want...hatches are great in the fall too! It is "two rivers in one".
